Arizona Dual Purpose Assessment (AIMS) 2010

This three-part statewide assessment is administered to Arizona students in grades 3-8 to determine their knowledge and understanding of the AIMS Academic Standards in reading, writing, mathematics and science. The AIMS-DPA also compares a student's performance nationally. The data provided by AIMS-DPA is used to help guide instruction and measure school performance. The following table comparing Summit School of Ahwatukee, the Kyrene School District and the State of Arizona was prepared from data released by the Arizona Department of Education and published in *The Arizona Republic*. The table indicates the percentage of students that met or exceeded Arizona standards at grades 3-8.

The Arizona Republic reported on August 13, 2008 “Summit students among state’s top performers on AIMS.”
