What to Expect This Summer

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP PROCEDURES

General Guidelines:

- All students (PS-8) will be dropped off and picked up in the MPR through the double doors at the front of the building. This entrance will be clearly marked during camp.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for transporting their children to and from camp.
- All campers must be signed in and out of camp each day by a designated guardian.
- Parents/Guardians and visitors must park in designated lined parking spaces only.
- Please do not park in such a way to hinder the flow of traffic or jeopardize the safety of children.
- Parking is not allowed along the red curbs. Do not park in the designated spaces purchased by parents/guardians at the annual Summit School Auction.
- State law prohibits neglect and endangerment of children. Never leave children unattended in a vehicle at any time, and always use car seats and seat belts.
- Students cannot be dropped off in the parking lots.
- Summit School is not responsible for damage to vehicles or theft. Please secure all valuables and use caution while moving through the parking lot.

WHAT TO BRING:

We will be limiting what children can bring from home.

- Pack a lunch each day for your camper.
- Snacks will be distributed once a day. Please send a snack with your child if you feel that they might be particular about snack foods served.
- Students need to bring a labeled reusable water bottle/thermos to camp every day. There are 3 water bottle filling stations that students can use to refill their water bottles and thermoses.
- Lunch containers and water bottles need to be taken home and washed daily.
